<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$1,650 per person with shared accommodation. • \$1,750 per person with private accommodation. • After February 1, and upon acceptance, a \$100 deposit is required <i>per person</i> to reserve your place on the tour. The balance must be paid upon arrival at SWRS. • Cancellation Policy: With at least 45 days advance notice from the start date, deposits will be refunded, less a \$20 cancellation fee. No deposits will be refunded with less notice. • Payment can be made with a personal or certified check, or money order, payable to SWRS. • Credit card payments may be made over the phone, but we ask that you keep in mind that the Station is a non-profit organization and fees for credit card charges continue to increase.
