Range: Cuba and nearby islands, the Cayman Islands, the Bahama Islands, Hispaniola, Navassa, and Martinique. Recently extinct species were found on Barbuda and Antigua, Anguilla, Guadeloupe, Hispaniola, Puerto Rico, and Jamaica.
