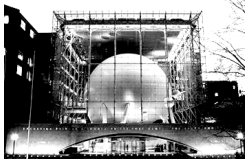


Lang Science Team

The AMNH Lang Science Program and Lang Scholars Awards were conceived by and established with founding support from the Eugene M. Lang Foundation.



The Lang Science Team at the American Museum of Natural History is looking to recruit a class of 22 current 5th graders join us for a 7-year science experience! For over 10 years, we have been providing a select group of students the opportunity to take classes at the Museum in which students:

- Participate in hands-on science
- Design and carry-out their own experiments while learning valuable research skills
- Hear from and visit the researchers working at the Museum who are working on cutting edge research in fields such as genetics, astrophysics, anthropology, and more!
- Tour the vast scientific collections that the Museum has amassed
- Go behind the scenes of exhibits, both new and old, to learn how they were developed
- Take field trips to other cultural institutions both near and far
- Receive help in applying to college, including trips to campuses, SAT prep, application help, and a scholarship!

Only 22 students will be chosen for this new team. To apply to the Lang Science Team, you must:

- Be a 5th grader in a New York City school
- Have your application filled out and sent to us by **May 15th, 2009**
- Be a motivated, independent student who is very interested in the sciences
- Be able to commit to program that runs through the end of 12th grade
- Be able to come to the Museum for 3 weeks in the summer, and twice a month on Saturdays during the school year
 - This summer, classes will run from July 27th – August 14th
 - We do our best to schedule our Saturday classes around the NYC Public School calendar – if you're on vacation, so are we!

The fee for this program is \$1500 per year. However, full scholarships to the Lang Science Team are available based on need, and ability to pay will NOT be a factor in determining acceptance into the program.
