Housing for Students in the Comparative Biology Ph.D. Program

Several types of rooms at International House will be available to the students enrolled in the AMNH Comparative Biology Ph.D. Program. These include traditional single, dormitory-style rooms with shared bathroom facilities (separate for men and women) on each floor; single rooms in apartments with shared kitchens; and studio and one-bedroom apartments. Single rooms in I. House South are completely furnished with a desk, bed, dresser, bookcase, lamp, chair, telephone, linens and towels. The average room size is 8' x 11' (2.4m x 3.4m) and some rooms have sinks or private or semi-private bathrooms. Three floors are designated as entirely non-smoking floors, while the other floors permit smoking in the individual resident rooms only. Prices for these rooms range from about \$715/month to about \$1225/month, depending on amenities and views.

I. House North is an apartment style building with studio and one bedroom apartments and 3, 4 or 5 bedroom apartment suites. All rooms and apartments are completely furnished and include utilities, but kitchenware is not provided.

- Studio & one-bedroom apartments are completely furnished with full bathrooms and kitchens. The studios are ~\$1450-1600/month, on floors 2-5, and approximately 16' X 12' (4.9m x 3.6m). The one-bedroom apartments are ~\$1700-1950/month, on floors 2-9 (no park or river views), and approximately 22' X 23' (6.7m x 7.0m). For AMNH students, priority for studio and one bedroom is given to couples applying for the first time.
- 2. Single rooms in apartment suites with shared kitchens and bathrooms for 3 to 5 people are fully furnished and range in size from 10' X 13' (3.0m x 3.9m) to 14' X 16' (4.3m x 4.9m). There are also a limited number of extra large rooms with private bathrooms (in 4 or 5 bedroom apartments on floors 9-12) at ~\$1400/month.
